Level 5	All five basic weapons to be demonstrated. (Must understand all moves and applications) Sai Tonfa Nunchaku Bo Katana  <b>IMPORTANT : LEVEL 5 STUDENTS WILL NOT MOVE ON TO LEVEL 4 WORK UNTIL THEY HAVE ACHIEVED THE GRADE OF 1ST DAN (ADULT)</b>	<b>Attendance Eligibility</b> Adults : Blue Belt & Above Juniors : Age 14+ & Brown 3rd Tag Belt & Above  Minimum attendance of 4 Ko Budo's  Brown Belts must obtain Level 5 before taking 1st Dan Grading
Level 4	Must be able to show all previous work plus:- Katana presentation and finish Naming parts of the Katana Kama 2nd Sai Kata Walking the Bo Could also be asked for any application	Minimum attendance of 5 Ko Budo's  Must be 1st Dan  1st Dan's must obtain Level 4 before taking 2nd Dan Grading
Level 3	All previous work, plus:- Naginata Katana Kata's 1-4 Okinawan Bo - 3 sets of 5 stances/blocks/strikes and fixed Kumite (1-10) Okinawan 1st Bo Kata Nunchaku Kata No.2	Minimum attendance of 6 Ko Budo's  2nd Dan's must obtain Level 3 before taking 3rd Dan Grading
Level 2	All previous work, plus:- Katana Kata 1-7 Okinawan Continuous Bo Kata Okinawan Bo Kata No.2 Jo vs Katana Kata 3rd Sai Kata (Okinawan) Must also have assisted with teaching since Level 3	Minimum attendance of 7 Ko Budo's  3rd Dan's must obtain Level 2 before taking 4th Dan Grading
Level 1	All previous work, plus:- Level 1 applicants to have demonstrated regular attendance and input at the majority of Ko-Budo Courses and to have reached a very high standard of both working and teaching, absorbing all new work as well as <b>all</b> the previous.	By Chief Instructors invitation only

**ALL STUDENTS BROWN BELT & ABOVE ARE EXPECTED TO ATTEND A MINIMUM OF 2 KO-BUDO COURSES PER YEAR. REGULAR PRACTICE DURING CLASS TIME IS ALSO REQUIRED TO MAINTAIN A GOOD STANDARD FOR DAN GRADINGS. ALL KO-BUDO INSTRUCTORS WILL BE REGULARLY ASSESSED.**
